**To whomsoever it may concern**

**Subject: St. Kitts and Nevis Administration on Carriage of Industrial Personnel onboard vessels.**

- St. Kitts and Nevis Flag Administration vide Letter Ref: ItnesJan2018-IndustrialPersonnel, dated 31 January 2018 (copy attached) has advised that the IMO Resolution MSC. 418(97) Reg “ Interim Recommendations on the Safe Carriage of more than 12 Industrial Personnel on board vessels engaged on International voyages” will not be currently implemented on vessels flying St. Kitts and Nevis Flag.
- Industrial personnel are to be carried on board St. Kitts and Nevis vessels taking into account the provisions of the Code of Safety for Special Purpose Ships, 2008.

Ship owners/ operators and masters of vessels flying St. Kitts and Nevis flag are advised to be guided by above.
